All *Drop-in & Dance classes* focus on building technique and skill.

Strength and flexibility conditioning will be a part of each class.

Instructors may use barre, across the floor, center floor work, combinations, or skill building stations to challenge dancers, while emphasizing the basic building blocks of dance.

These classes will not focus on choreography.

Which class is right for me?

Intermediate

Age 7 & older

Recommended for:

- Younger competition dancers
- Competition dancers who only compete in tap or tumbling
- Advanced Recreational dancers (as designated by PDC)

Advanced

Age 10 & older

Recommended for:

- Competition girls age 10 or older, with strong ballet technique
- Competition boys age 12 or older
- PDC PRO dancers

Beginner/Recreational

Age 7 & older

Recommended for:

- Beginners
- Recreational dancers

Sign up for classes that are right for you and your individual abilities. Do not sign-up for a class that does not match your ability level, just to be with a friend. Drop-in style classes are common in the dance industry. Instructors will not adjust class curriculum for you. PDC instructors will lead intermediate and advanced classes at a faster pace. Talking or playing around in class will not be tolerated. PDC does not issue refunds.
